Parish Council Housing Survey: The Results

The Parish Council's Housing Survey was carried out in September 2015 to help the PC decide if a Neighbourhood Plan will be necessary. Below is a summary — click a blue question number to see its data. When considering a question's outcome, please take into account the number of respondents who answered that question.

Overview: From the 590 houses and 1,475 population of the Parish (2011 Census), 299 individuals answered. Just over half were female; 71% used the paper form delivered to every house; 29% replied via the internet. The majority lived in Barcombe Cross; Spithurst, Barcombe Mills and Town Littleworth were all represented.

Q1 Property ownership: 78% own own property, 23% rent (296 r	responses)
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- Q2.1 Are you likely to move in the next ten years? 53% no, 47% yes (298 responses)
- Q2.2 Why are you likely to move? 33% want a smaller property, 17% want more space (136 responses)
- Q3 If you move, will you stay in the parish? 46% want to stay, 28% be within five miles (158 responses)
- Q4 If staying, what sort of home would you prefer? 43% three-bed house, 28% two beds (72 responses)
- Q5 If staying, do you have others who might move here? 81% no, 19% yes (299 responses)





Q2.1: In the next ten years, are you likely to consider moving?








Q5: If you plan to stay in Barcombe parish, do you have friends or relatives who would like to move here?













Q9.1: Would you support more than 30 new homes in Barcombe Cross before 2030?

Q9.2: Would you be happy for new homes to be built all at once?




Q11: Do you live, work or work from home in Barcombe parish?


Q12: Which age group are you in?
